



MASTER IN EDUCATION WITH A SPECIALIZATION IN ADMINISTRATION AND EDUCATIONAL SUPERVISION



This specialty trains you with the knowledge, skills and the necessary attitudes to make decisions and solve educational problems that may arise in the performance of the administrative, teaching or teaching support functions in public and private schools of the country.

This specialization provides for its graduates to serve as school principals at the elementary and secondary levels. In addition, it provides much of the requirements to serve as a supervisor of school services or educational programs. You can also work with businesses and community groups with vision and academic programs.

REQUIREMENTS

Students will be required to complete 42 credits divided as follows: 18 credits in medullar courses and 24 credits in specialty credits:

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

New Entry Students General Requirements for all Master's programs:

- Complete Application for Admission and pay the admission fee (non-refundable)
- Have graduated from high school with an academic index of 2.50 GPA or more 3/4 The candidate who does not meet the minimum required average must have passed the last 60 credits of his baccalaureate with an average of 2.50 or more.

- Official credit transcript of the university where you finished your baccalaureate program or university of origin.
- Two letters of recommendation (must include a teacher or supervisor).

SPECIFIC ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:

Prospects for a master's degree in education and who do not possess a bachelor's degree in education

- Six (6) sub-graduate credits in Education will be required from an accredited university.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Complete Application for Admission and pay the fee (non-refundable).
- Original Immunization Certificate (Form P-VAC 3), for students under the age of 21.
- Transcript of Credits from accredited University Institution of origin with a cumulative average of 2.50 or more.
