REQUIREMENTS

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

New Entry Students General Requirements for all Master's programs:

- Complete Application for Admission and pay the admission fee (non-refundable) Have graduated from high school with an academic index of 2.50 GPA or more 3/4 The candidate who does not meet the minimum required average must have passed the last 60 credits of his baccalaureate with an average of 2.50 or more.
- Official credit transcript of the university where you finished your baccalaureate program or university of origin.
- Two letters of recommendation (must include a teacher or supervisor).

SPECIFIC ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:

Prospects for a master's degree in education and who do not possess a bachelor's degree in education

- Six (6) sub-graduate credits in Education will be required from an accredited university.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Complete Application for Admission and pay the fee (non-refundable).
- Original Immunization Certificate (Form P-VAC 3), for students under the age of 21.
- Transcript of Credits from accredited University Institution of origin with a cumulative average of 2.50 or more.
