ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

New Students – General Requirements

- Complete the admission application form and pay the admission fee (non-refundable)
- Submit an official credit transcript that evidences attainment of a bachelor's degree with a GPA of 2.50 or more.
- Official credit transcript from the university where you finished your baccalaureate program or university of origin.

SPECIFIC ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:

Prospects for a master's degree in education and who do not possess a bachelor's degree in education

- Six (6) sub-graduate credits in Education will be required from an accredited university.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

- Complete Application for Admission and pay the fee (non-refundable).
- Original Immunization Certificate (Form P-VAC 3), for students under the age of 21.
- Official Transcript of Credits from accredited University Institution of origin with a cumulative average of 2.50 or more.
